



Mahane Israel

Known as “Hamugrabim”\“The Westerners” (Hmaraviem). Built by the Mughrabis (the Moroccans) and for them to inhabit, Mahane Israel and Mishkanot Sha’ananim are the first Jewish neighborhoods to be built outside the Old City walls. Mahane Israel is the first to be built by the Old City’s residents for themselves. During the last years, various works of preservation were held and are still being held today. The neighborhood houses many synagogues of different denominations. It is located five minutes away from Jaffa Gate (the only gate on the western side of the Old City) and 15 minutes away from the Wailing Wall (“HaKotel”).
