



Old Katamon

Old Katamon is dubbed “The flower Garden of Jerusalem.” Dating back to the British Mandate, Old Katamon is situated between Talbieh neighborhood to the north and the German and Greek Colonies to the East.

The two central streets in the neighborhood, Rachel Imenu (running in the east - west direction) and Kovshe Katamon (running in the north - south direction) connect with stylish and quaint Emek Refaim Street.

As part of the general renewal process in the area, which began in the early 1970's, architectural styles not previously seen in the area emerged: stone courtyards, fences, quality porches and tiled roofs. Centrally located Katamon neighborhood has a romantic, sentimental style, and is the home of small, artistic houses with yards, many schools and synagogues.
